Region: Douro

SOIL: Schist

GRAPE VARIETIES: 40% Touriga Franca, 30% Touriga Nacional, 20% Tinta Roriz and 10% Alicante Bouchet

Analytic Values:

ALCOHOL: 13%

pH: 3.65

TOTAL ACIDITY: 5.3 g/L

VOLATILE ACIDITY: 0,8 g/L

RESIDUAL SUGAR: 0,6 g/L

Bottling: 12 666 bottles (**Bottling date:** 9th July 2020)

VINIFICATION: In stainless steel vats with temperature control of 26° C

AGEING: 50% of the final blend ages in 225L used French oak barrels for 6 months

TASTING NOTES: Vivid ruby color, intense aromas of matured red fruits, with some hints of black plums and light oak notes. A full-bodied wine with excellent structure, where the tannins are matured and well-integrated. On the mouth, a persistent finish.
